

In 1973 when we were searching for a place to resettle our pottery and life, we chose Bethel on an impulse. As we drove up Main Street that December we saw this house and barn and felt it was a good place for us.

During the passing years we have built on what we recognized intuitively. The beautiful colors in the mountains and valleys, the extreme weather and the people in the community enrich our life and affect the reason and rhythm of our work.

We invite you to visit our studio. Bethel is in Western Maine, reached by Routes 26, 2 and 5. There are highway signs directing you to Bonnema Pottery on Main Street.

Our store is open daily from 9A.M. to 5P.M. We will pack your purchase carefully for the trip home and can ship by United Parcel if you have more traveling to do. We accept personal checks and bank credit cards.

Our store contains a large representation of stoneware and porcelain. We love color and offer over fifty color combinations from which you can custom order any of the pieces we make.

Our work includes lamps, garden furniture, dinnerware and tiles. These tiles are hand cut and individually glazed for use on floors and walls.

Many people comment on the bright colors of our pottery. We have the rich browns associated with stoneware. We also have pastels—yellows and greens and bright purples, aquas and blues.

It is our hope that whatever piece you choose, it will remind you of your visit to our beautiful region.
